End Times – The Return of the King by Pastor Joseph Yu

This course explores the study of "last things," including death, judgment, the afterlife, and the end of the world. By the end of class, you will understand how ideas about the future shape human hope, belief and daily life today.

Introduction to the Bible by Hansel and Andrew

The Bible and How Not to Read It" is the first course in reading the Bible for understanding. It consists of two parts. The first part examines the nature of the Bible (the Old and the New Testaments)—addressing the role of the Bible in believers' lives, its origins, and its transmission. The second part explains how the Bible should be read correctly (2Ti 2:15). As the Bible is an ancient work of literature written over two thousand years ago under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, modern readers must approach it with humility, deference, and care.

Philippians by YC Ip

Paul's Epistle to the Philippians is one of the most personal and theologically concentrated of Paul's letters. It is a relatively short (less than 2100 words with 104 verses) letter, but it provides answers to such important questions as: Christian identity, Christ's humility and exaltation, the Church community, Christian joy and prayers and the ultimate Christian hope.

Let the Little Children Come – Mark 10:13-16

Mark 10:13a

People (Parents) brought little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them because they believed that Jesus would make life better

- Do my actions tell others that Jesus makes your life better?

Mark 10:13b

but the disciples rebuked the parents who brought the little children to Jesus.

How Jesus's disciples viewed and treated the little children reveals what they thought the kingdom of God is like

- What do my actions tell me about the requirements and pre-requisites -to enter the kingdom of God -that I set for myself and for others?

Mark 10:14

Jesus was indignant at his disciples for rebuking the people and the little children. He said to them, "Let the little children come to me"

God intentionally put the people around us to help us learn and grow to be more like Jesus

- As I follow Jesus, what do I learn about the kingdom of God? Am I welcoming the children and those whom society does not value?

Mark 10:15

Jesus emphasizes that all disciples must receive the kingdom of God like a little child

Instead of the worries and distractions of the world, little children are focused on God at all times

- How do I model and teach the children about the goodness and faithfulness of God?

Mark 10:16

Jesus took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them.

The church, Jesus's disciples, are the body of Christ.

- How can I let the little children come to Jesus?

Reflection: How can I learn to receive the kingdom of God like little children?

Practical Steps

- Talk with a child, a children worker, or a parent about what they think about following Jesus
- If the Holy Spirit prompts, talk with a fellowship counsellor, or a pastor about serving in children ministry
- Pray for the children to know Jesus and have joy in him
