- 4. Proverbs 14:15 says that "A simple man believes anything, but a prudent man gives thought to his steps." How do you process information before sharing with others? How do you know if something is true?

5. In 1 Corinthians 2 Jesus is the full embodiment of God's wisdom. For Jesus, to know him is to be in relationship with him. If that is the case, how can we gain wisdom?
